Discipline Standards for Misconduct

265-010-0001

Sexual Assault

(1) A disciplining body shall impose upon a law enforcement officer disciplinary action [*within the following disciplinary range*] of **termination** upon a finding that the officer engaged in **misconduct** conduct constituting an act of sexual assault **that constitutes a sex crime as defined in ORS 163A.005.**

((1) The presumptive sanction shall be termination.

((2) The mitigated sanction shall be suspension without pay, salary reduction, demotion, or a written reprimand.)

(2) A disciplining body shall impose upon a law enforcement officer disciplinary action within the following range upon a finding that the officer engaged in misconduct constituting unwanted conduct of a sexual nature that does not constitute a sex crime.

(a) The presumptive sanction shall be salary reduction, demotion or suspension without pay.

(b) The mitigated sanction shall be a written reprimand.

(c) The aggravated sanction shall be termination.
