Discipline Standards for Misconduct

265-010-0001

Sexual Assault

**(1) A disciplining body shall impose upon a law enforcement officer disciplinary action ~~[within the following disciplinary range]~~ of termination** upon a finding that the officer engaged in ~~misconduct~~ **conduct** constituting an act of sexual assault **that constitutes a sex crime as defined in ORS 163A.005.**

~~[(1) The presumptive sanction shall be termination.~~

~~(2) The mitigated sanction shall be suspension without pay, salary reduction, demotion, or a written reprimand.]~~

**(2) A disciplining body shall impose upon a law enforcement officer disciplinary action within the following range upon a finding that the officer engaged in misconduct constituting unwanted conduct of a sexual nature that does not constitute a sex crime.**

**(a) The presumptive sanction shall be salary reduction, demotion or suspension without pay.**

**(b) The mitigated sanction shall be a written reprimand.**

**(c) The aggravated sanction shall be termination.**
